

Charles T. Haworth Graduate Scholarship for Veterans

Retired Florida State University economics professor Charles Haworth has generously provided funding for annual scholarships totaling \$20,000 to veterans pursuing master's degrees in the College of Social Science and Public Policy. The four \$5,000 scholarships are designated for military veterans accepted into a master's program within the college, and applications for the Haworth Scholarship should be submitted in accordance with the guidelines listed below.

The Award

The Haworth Scholarship totals \$5,000 per student-veteran per year (\$2,500 for the fall and spring semesters) and may be renewed for a second year if an awardee is enrolled in a master's degree program that normally takes two years to complete. The award is allocated by semester and continuation requires normal progress being made toward the degree. There are no tuition waivers or work requirements attached to these awards.

Eligibility

Florida State University student veterans who have been accepted into a master's program in the College of Social Sciences and Public Policy are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Application

Student veterans who are eligible and wish to be considered for the Haworth Scholarship must submit the form below, an official undergraduate transcript, a copy of their GRE score (if available), a statement of purpose not to exceed 400 words, and one letter of recommendation from a university professor.

Applicants should also submit their resume and a one-page cover letter that documents their record of military service and articulates how this award will further their graduate study at FSU. These materials should be sent via e-mail to Tonja Guilford – tguilford@fsu.edu – no later than May 1.

Selection

The College of Social Sciences will determine the recipients and monitor awardees' progress to the degree in cooperation with the academic department.
